About

The Washington Nationals Baseball Club has approximately 250 employees at the team’s headquarters in Washington DC, and their spring training facility in Viera, Florida. This includes baseball managers, scouts, trainers, team staff, players, and operational departmental front office personnel who generate 1,800 expense reports every year (in and off season). The Club’s annual T&E spend, tightly controlled and managed, is over \$700,000.

Challenge

The Club’s players could send a baseball soaring across the field with lightning speed, but The Club’s expense reporting system was sluggish and inefficient. Club finance leaders wanted to reduce the number of hours travelers spent completing expense reports, speed up reimbursement and eliminate any risk of errors and fraud.
